
# 2.1 About The Gambia

### Location

The Gambia is an ECOWAS country located in West Africa. It is uniquely shaped, following the path of the Gambia River inland. It is almost entirely surrounded by Senegal, except for its short Atlantic Ocean coastline to the west.

### **Official Language**

The official language is English. However, several national languages are widely spoken in daily life, including Mandinka, Wolof, Fula (Pulaar), Jola, and Serer.






## 2.2 About The Gambia

### **Capital of the Republic**

The capital of the Republic of The Gambia is **Banjul**, located on an island at the mouth of the Gambia River. However, the largest city and main economic hub is **Serekunda**, where most of the population resides.





# 3.1 GENERAL INFORMATION

- The Gambia experiences its rainy season from June to October, with July August being one of the wettest months of the year. Participants can expect high humidity, frequent rain showers, and temperatures ranging between 25°C and 32°C (77°F to90°F).
- Participants are advised to pack light, breathable clothing and appropriate footwear.
- Security arrangements will be in place for all participants.



## 3.2 GENERAL INFORMATION

#### **Time Zone**


The time zone for The Gambia is UTC/GMT+0, with no daylight saving time observed

#### **Mobile Telecommunications Services**

The international telephone code for The Gambia is +220.

Mobile telecommunications are widely available through several operators, including Africell, Qcell, Comium, and Gamcel. Sim cards are free and available at the airport. Mobile numbers in The Gambia are typically 7 digits long and start with specific prefixes depending on the provider.

Foreign mobile phones can generally be used in The Gambia, provided they are unlocked and compatible with the GSM 900/1800 MHz frequency bands used in the country. Roaming services and local SIM cards are both available for international visitors.





## 3.3 GENERAL INFORMATION

### **Meeting Language**

To ensure inclusive and effective participation, simultaneous interpretation will be available in all official ECOWAS languages (English, French and Portuguese) throughout all plenary sessions, thematic discussions, and high-level panels. Participants are encouraged to speak in either language, with interpretation provided to facilitate dialogue and engagement.

### **Currency**

The Gambian Dalasi (GMD) is the official currency. USD and EUR are widely accepted and can be exchanged easily. ATMs and exchange bureaus are available in Banjul. It's useful to note that while some hotels and large establishments may accept international credit/debit cards, functionality and connectivity may vary and participants are therefore advised to carry a reasonable amount of local currency for convenience.

#### **Dress Code**

Both formal business attire and African traditional attire are allowed throughout the Forum.

# **Health Requirements**




Vaccination against yellow fever is mandatory. Vaccination against COVID 19 is optional. Recommended vaccinations: tetanus, typhoid fever, hepatitis A and B.



The Yellow fever vaccination certificate will be required upon arrival.

It should be noted that travellers who have not complied with this formality prior to their arrival may be received by the public health services when they get off the plane.

First aid will be provided by medical staff at the conference venue.





# 3.5 GENERAL INFORMATION


### **Security**

The Gambia is generally considered a peaceful and politically stable country. The government continues to invest in improving public safety and strengthening law enforcement. As in any destination, travelers are advised to take normal precautions and stay informed through official sources.

## 3.6 GENERAL INFORMATION

### **Electricity**

Power sockets in The Gambia supply a standard voltage of **230V** with a frequency of **50Hz**. If your appliances use voltage in the **220V–240V** range, they can be safely used. The Gambia typically uses **Type G plugs and sockets**, which are the same as those used in the United Kingdom. Travelers may need a plug adapter depending on their home country.

### **Food service at ESEF**

During the two days of the Forum, **lunch will be provided** to all speakers, moderators, sponsored participants, and special guests. Additionally, **designated food vendors and restaurants** will be available at the venue for other participants.

### Airport pick-up and transfer


ECREEE is pleased to welcome all ESEF 2025 participants at Banjul International Airport (BJL), Banjul, The Gambia. A dedicated protocol service, bearing the ESEF 2025 identification, will be clearly visible for any additional support, if required.

#### **Before your trip, make sure you have:**

- 1. your round-trip air ticket
- 2. your letter of invitation or confirmation of participation
- 3. Entry Visa Clearance
- 4. your hotel reservation
- 5. your valid International Vaccination Certificate

### **Transport between the Hotel and the Meeting Venue**

A pick-up service will be provided between the hotels designated by ESEF 2025 and the meeting venue. Please check the pick-up schedule before the event. The timetable will be provided to you when you are met at the airport and will also be available in the lobby of the ESEF 2025 Partner Hotels and at the meeting venue.

Banjul, by the organisers upon presentation of your QR Code.






# 6. Entry Requirements

The Gambia is a visa free country for all citizens of ECOWAS, and diplomatic passport holders. Please note Visa can be obtained:

- 1. At any Gambian Embassy
- Visa upon arrival at Banjul International Airport (BJL), Cost:7, 000 Gambian Dalasi
  or its equivalent in foreign currencies (USD, EUR, GBP, XOF CFA)
- 3. Commonwealth Member States would not require visa to travel to The Gambia; however, they will need Entry Clearance before departure.
- 4. See attached Gambia new visa policy document.
- 5. Yellow fever vaccination certificate

#### **SECURIPORT AIRPORT FEE -:**

Non-diplomatic passport holders are required to pay \$20 on arrival at BJL as well as on departure.
