About the Forum

The inaugural ECOWAS Sustainable Energy Forum (ESEF) was held in 2016 in Accra, Ghana, with subsequent editions hosted as follows: ESEF 2017 and ESEF 2018 in Dakar, Senegal; ESEF 2019 in Accra, Ghana; ESEF 2020 and ESEF 2021 virtually due to COVID 19; ESEF 2022 in Abuja, Nigeria; ESEF 2023 in Praia, Cape Verde, and ESEF 2024 in Abidjan Cote d'Ivoire.

ESEF serves as a strategic platform to accelerate investments in renewable energy and energy efficiency across West Africa. The forum fosters regional cooperation and partnerships to develop viable markets for sustainable energy solutions within ECOWAS.



By bringing together policymakers, international, regional and national partners, private sector leaders, financial institutions, investors, and other key stakeholders, ESEF strengthens the institutional, policy, and regulatory frameworks needed to attract public and private investments in the energy transition in the region.

Over the past eight years, ESEF has established itself as the West Africa's Premier Energy Event, annually convening more than 500 participants. Attendees include ministers, heads of international and regional organizations, financial institution leaders, investors, private sector executives, researchers, experts, students, and civil society representatives working across energy, environment, and climate sectors.

- 01 Advancing Sustainable Energy Goals – Supporting ECOWAS member states in achieving their sustainable energy targets and commitments
- 02 Unlocking Investment Opportunities – Promoting viable investment prospects across West Africa’s renewable energy and energy efficiency sectors
- 03 Strengthening Policy & Partnerships – Serving as a high-level networking platform for key stakeholders including policymakers, public and private sector stakeholders, and financial institutions, to improve regulatory frameworks and attract regional/international investments in sustainable energy
- 04 Accelerating Clean Energy Deployment – Fostering regional cooperation to scale up smart mini-grid solutions, off-grid solar systems, and renewable-integrated electricity markets
- 05 Driving a Just Energy Transition – Exploring innovative pathways including energy efficiency, accelerating distributed generation, clean cooking, green hydrogen, e-mobility, energy-water-food nexus solutions, and gender-inclusive energy access

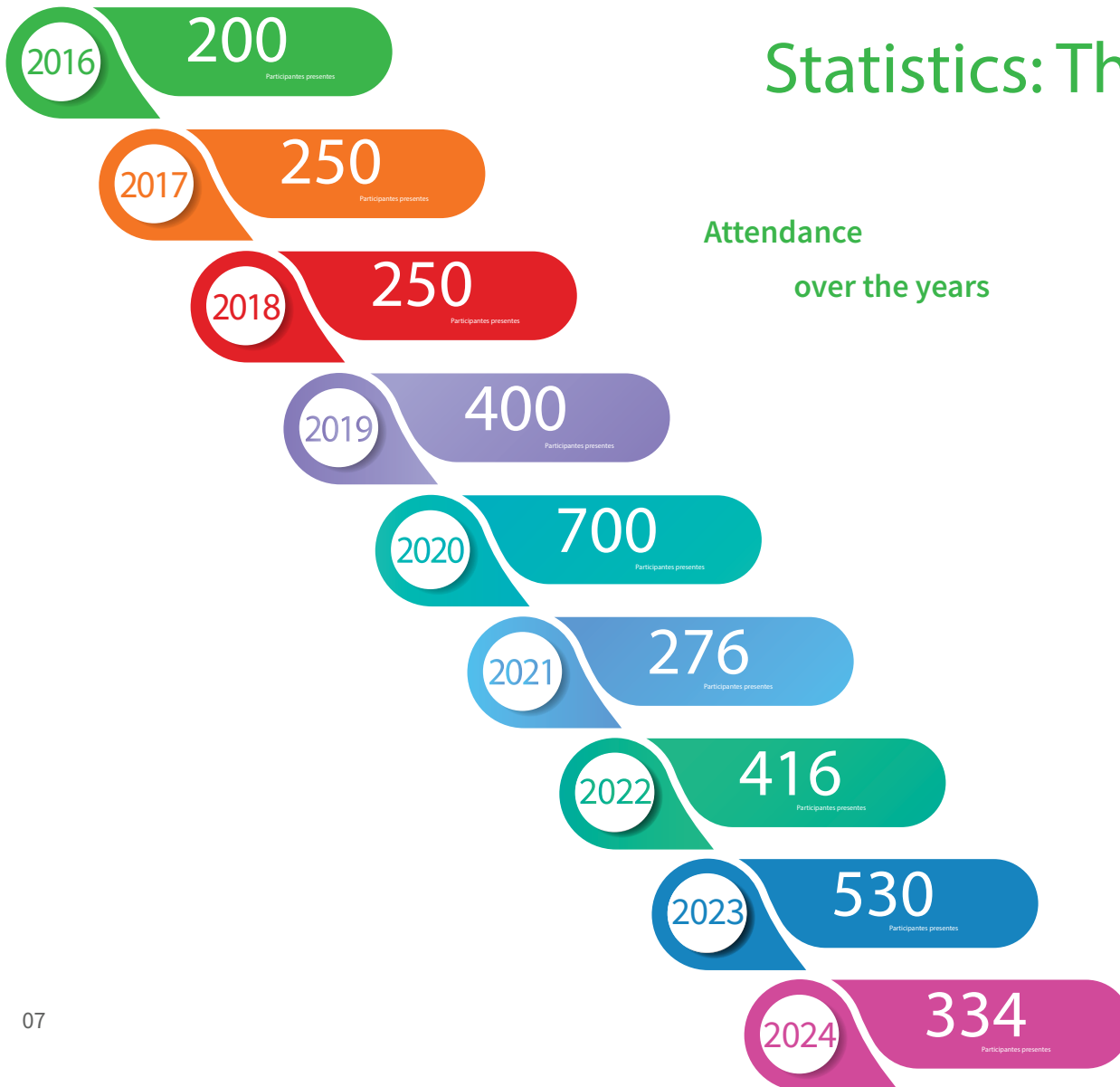

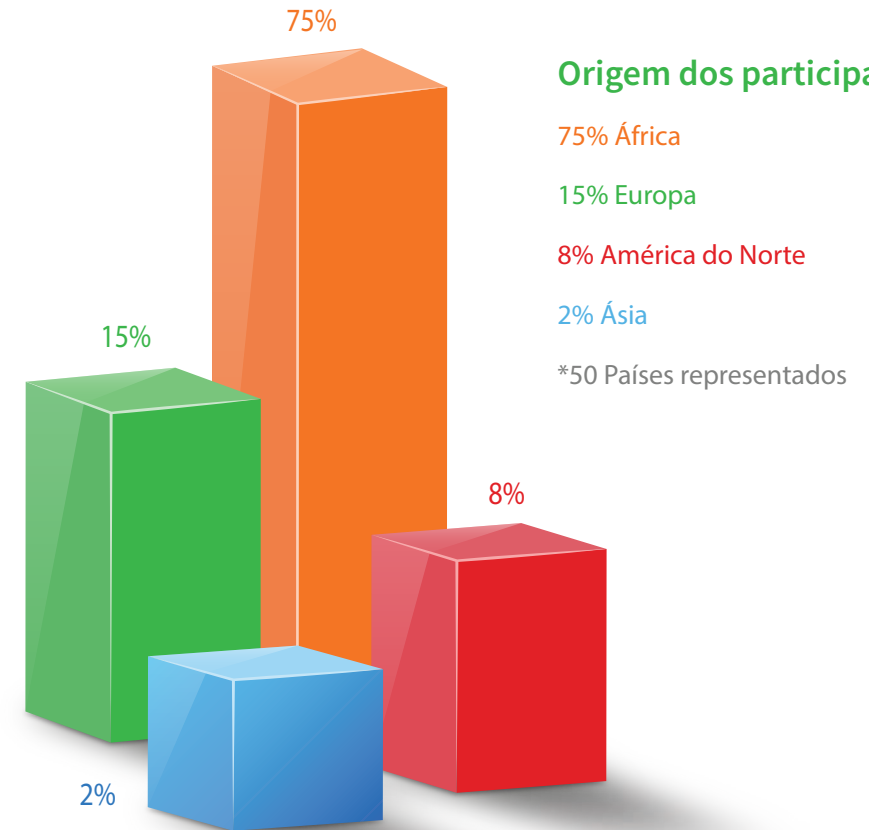

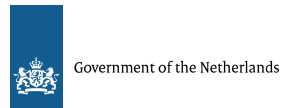
